
WHEN SHOULD I VACCINATE MY HORSES?

The Equine Infectious Diseases Advisory Board have developed an easy to follow vaccination protocol. We recommend you use these guidelines when planning an annual vaccination schedule for your horses.



NOTE: In the event that you are unsure of your horse's vaccination status, consult your vet about undertaking a Vaccination Priming Regimen * Priming protocol is one dose at eight, nine and ten months of pregnancy ** Foals born to mares vaccinated with Equivac HeV should commence vaccination at 6 months of age.
